Minister of Engagement First Christian Church

General Job Description:

The primary goal for the Minister of Engagement is to assist the Senior Minister in duties and to collaborate with the Senior Minister and other lay leaders to design and implement programs to attract young families and youth to First Christian Church.

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

Support the Senior Minister in overall leadership of the Church's teaching and weekend service planning, design, and execution.

Work to develop the Church's community presence by external marketing activities and special outreach events.

Develop small group and Bible study groups for young adults.

Serve as the primary person for welcome, offering and closing comments on Sunday mornings in two services.

Work to develop Sunday School programs, group activities and outreach for youth.

Organize and lead the church's local, regional, and national mission efforts with a special emphasis on involving youth.

Work with youth director to develop and coordinate all youth activities.

Assist in the selection of videos and other creative elements of Sunday services.

Function as backup for Senior Minister's duties on Sunday when needed. This will require a minimum of six sermons annually.

Coordinate the annual sermon calendar, including a separate calendar used for long-range planning.

Serve as director of annual Vacation Bible School.

Assist with visitations at hospitals, nursing homes, assisted living centers and residences as needed.

Other duties and tasks as assigned.

Minor Duties and Responsibilities:

Serve on the Outreach Committee with an emphasis on involving youth in all outreach initiatives.

Serve on the Nurture Committee with an emphasis on involving youth in all nurture initiatives.

Education Qualifications:

The potential candidate is preferred to be a fully ordained minister or working on seminary studies with a study plan, including an end date, approved by the Search Committee. Additionally, consideration will be given to a candidate who is a commissioned minister in good standing with the Region or one who has commensurate life experience and would be willing to enter a commissioned/ certificate ministry track while under care of the Regional Office.

Proven ability to develop, coordinate and manage.

Proven experience in marketing.

Proven experience in creative initiatives.

People oriented in all areas.

Relationship building skills with a goal of whole-family ministry.

Must have the ability to appeal inter-generationally.

Must have social media experience with aptitude in all social media platforms.

Other Qualifications:

Prefer familiarity with contemporary Christian music.

Preference given to candidates with musical capabilities and particularly to guitar-playing abilities.

Must be invested in the church camp experience.

Brief description of First Christian Church:
