#### The extinguishing of the Christ Candle

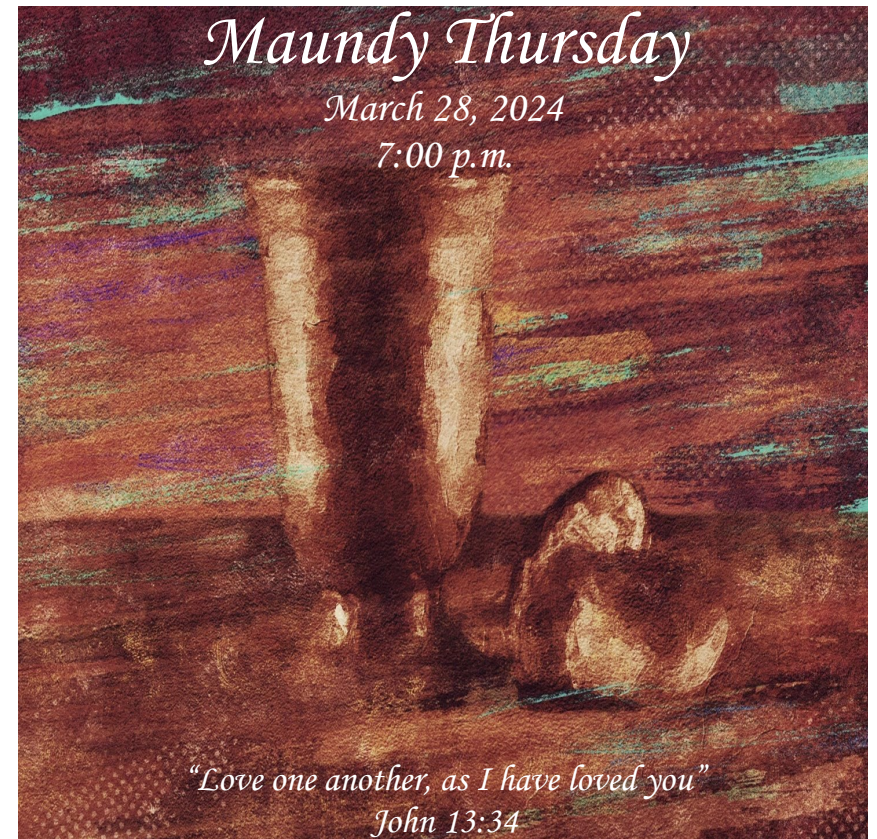
#### Tolling of the Bell
